

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2015 QUOTA ORDINANCE FOR THE NORTH LITTLE ROCK POLICE DEPARTMENT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City Council is responsible for establishing the number of employees in each department; and

WHEREAS, based upon experience and proven job skills, certain North Little Rock Police Department non-uniformed employees have progressed in their positions, and there is a need to add the new position of “Community Service Assistant II, F07” for the Department; and

WHEREAS, there will not be an increase in the total number of non-uniformed positions for the Police Department since the number of positions assigned for Community Service Assistant will be reduced by four and added to the new position of Community Service Assistant II.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That Section 23 of Ordinance No. 8711 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 23: That the Police Department shall consist of two hundred thirty eight (238) full-time employees (202 uniformed and 36 non-uniformed) as follows:

Uniformed:

- Chief, NEG – 1
- Assistant Chief, NG – 1
- Captain, X04 - 4
- Lieutenant, X03 –10
- Sergeant, X02 - 25
- Police Officer, X01 – 161

Non-uniformed:

- Automated Systems Assistant, F05 – 1

**Community Service Assistant, F05 – ~~8~~ 4 Delete 4 positions**

**Community Service Assistant II, F07 – 4 Add four positions**

- Computer Specialist, F10 - 3
- Executive Secretary, NG
- Fleet Maintenance/Inventory Manager, F05 - 1

Manager of Information Systems, NEG – 1  
Media Production Specialist, F09A - 1  
Office Assistant III, F05 –11  
Office Manager, F10 – 1  
Payroll Accounting Clerk, F06A – 1  
Secretary III, F05A – 6  
Victim’s Advocate, F08A – 1

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3: That the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any section, phrase or provision shall be declared or held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the sections, phrases or provisions.

SECTION 4: That the City Council has determined that the interests of the City and City employees can best be served by the adoption of this ordinance; THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.




