

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH REDSTONE CONSTRUCTION GROUP, INC. FOR OVERLAY WORK FOR EAST BETHANY STREET AND ALLEN STREET UNDER THE 2015 ASPHALT OVERLAY PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 14-54-601 contracts for street improvements must be authorized by City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Little Rock (“the City”) advertised for bids under the 2015 Asphalt Overlay Program for overlay work for East Bethany Street (from Hwy. 161 Right-of-Way to Eureka Gardens Road) and Allen Street (from West 47th Street to West 42nd Street) (see Notice attached hereto as Exhibit “A”); and

WHEREAS, the low bidder for the project was Redstone Construction Group, Inc. with a bid of \$108,221.75 (see Bid Summary No. 15-3363 attached hereto as Exhibit “B”).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a overlay work pursuant to the City’s 2015 Asphalt Overlay Program (said contract being substantially similar to Exhibit “C” attached hereto) with Redstone Construction Group, Inc. in the amount \$108,221.75.

SECTION 2: That funds for the 2015 Asphalt Overlay Program have been included in the City’s 2015 Budget.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.





Bids will be received by the City of North Little Rock, Arkansas in the office of the Department of Commerce and Government Affairs until the date given on the Bid Invitation for the following work:

The work involves the placement of approximately 1,030 tons of 1 ¾ inch PG 64-22 ACHM with full width milling for East Bethany Street from Hwy 161 Right-of-Way to Eureka Gardens Road, as well as Allen Street from W 47th Street to W 42nd Street.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities in the bids, as well as alterations of any locations if mutually agreed.

The City also reserves the right to reduce the total amount of work to be done as required by budget restraints. Also, work added or remaining shall be at the same unit price as submitted in the proposal.

A 5% Bid Bond or Certified Check is required to be submitted with the bid.

Plans and Specifications are available at no charge in the Office of Commerce and Government Affairs.


Bidders are advised the City intends for the Contractor to start work in October or November after the award of the project.

Hereinafter called Contractor.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the payments and agreement hereinafter mentioned to be made and performed by the OWNER, the CONTRACTOR hereby agrees with the OWNER to commence and complete the design and construction described as follows:

2015 Asphalt Overlay Program – East Bethany Street and Allen Street

hereinafter called the project (for the sum of \$108,221.75 Dollars (\$) and all extra work in connection therewith, under the terms as stated in the General and Special Conditions of the Contract; and at his (it's or their) own proper cost and expense to furnish all the materials, supplies, machinery, equipment, tools, superintendence, labor, insurance, and other accessories and services necessary to complete the said project in accordance with the conditions and prices stated in the Proposal, the General Conditions, Supplemental Plans, which include all maps, plats, blue prints, and other drawings and printed or written explanatory matter thereof, the specifications and contract documents therefore as prepared by the City Engineering Department, herein entitled the Engineer, all of which are made a part hereof and collectively evidence and constitute the contract.

The Contractor hereby agrees to commence work under this Contract on or before a date to be specified in a written "Notice to Proceed" of the Owner and to fully complete the project within 30 working days thereafter. The Contractor further agrees to pay, as liquidated damages, the sum of \$50.00 for each consecutive calendar day thereafter as hereinafter provided.

The Owner agrees to pay the CONTRACTOR in current funds for the performance of the Contract, subject to additions and deductions, as provided in the General Conditions of the Contract.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties thereto present have executed this Contract in four (4) counter parts, each of which shall be deemed an original, in the year and day first above mentioned.
