

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARING
CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK
PROPOSED 2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN
FOR HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

Notice is hereby given of a public comment period on the City of North Little Rock’s proposed Annual Action Plan for 45th Year (2019) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and 2019 Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) program funding. The 30 day public comment period will begin on May 12, 2019 and end on June 10, 2019. Copies of the Plan will be available for review at City Hall, 300 Main Street, North Little Rock, AR 72114 and at the Community Development Agency (CDA) at 500 West 13th Street, North Little Rock, AR 72114. The Plan will be posted on the City’s website at www.nlr.ar.gov/communitydevelopment. A Public Hearing will be held on Monday, June 10, 2019, in the City Council Chambers of North Little Rock City Hall, 300 Main Street, North Little Rock, AR, in conjunction with the regularly scheduled City Council meeting at 6:00 p.m., at which time the Council will consider adoption of the 2019 Annual Action Plan.

The purpose of the Public Comment Period and the Public Hearing is to receive comments from North Little Rock residents on the strategies and priorities outlined in the Plan for addressing the needs of low and moderate income households and neighborhoods. Comments must be received by June 10, 2019. Comments received will be considered prior to Council adoption of the Plan. A summary of comments received will be attached to the Plan prior to its submission to HUD.

The proposed 2019 Annual Action Plan includes annual goals and objectives for housing and community development; the projected use of the 2019 program year funds; and the specific method for distributing CDBG and HOME funds. It serves as an application for funding under these programs.
